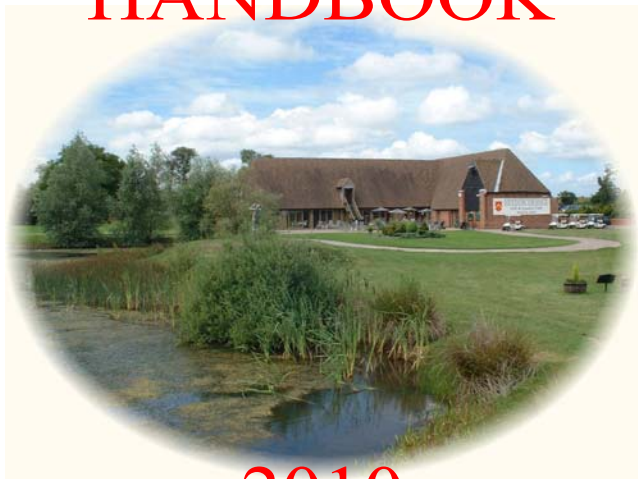

RULES & REGULATIONS OF PLAY

GENERAL

1. No team matches other than those in the Fixture List may be played on any of the Courses without the previous permission of the Management.
2. Members who reserve starting times are expected to play at those times. Members who subsequently find they are unable to do so are to immediately notify the Management to enable others to reserve those times instead.
3. Junior members may play in Club Trophy Competitions (other than those held exclusively for Juniors) with a maximum handicap of 28.
4. All members shall comply with the dress code as defined by the Management. Male members may wear shorts of a type approved by the Secretary. As a guide golf or similar tailored shorts will be required with golf socks. Jeans must NOT be worn either on the course or in the Clubhouse at any time. Golf or sports shoes must not be worn in the Clubhouse.
5. Mobile phones are not allowed to be used on the course or in the clubhouse except in emergency.
6. No dogs shall be allowed in the Clubhouse or on the Course.
7. Distance Measuring Devices: For all play at this course, (with the exceptions listed under ladies rule 4) a player may use a distance-measuring device to obtain distance information. However, if, during a stipulated round, a player uses a device that actually provides information on other conditions that might affect their play (e.g. temperature, gradient, wind etc), the player is in breach of Rule 14-3, for which the penalty is disqualification. When playing County or external sponsored matches refer to the Competition Rules.
8. Walking off the course: **Applicable to all Competitions and Medals.** Players are only permitted to leave the course during a round under the circumstances described in Rule 6-8a. Any player leaving the course for a reason other than covered under 6-8a should report to the committee as soon as practicable. If the committee consider the reasons satisfactory there is no penalty; otherwise the player is disqualified and the Committee may impose a two competition ban.
9. Please note that all members should maintain a valid handicap by submitting a minimum of three qualifying cards per year. If you do not submit 3 cards during 2010, you will become ineligible for certain Heydon Grange, county and other events. If in doubt, consult the handicap secretaries.

RULES & REGULATIONS OF PLAY

LADIES

1. A Member may not enter any Club competition other than a competition for Juniors unless she holds a current CONGU handicap.
2. Entry fees for all competitions must be paid prior to entry, and no Member's name will be put into the draw if her entry fee has not been paid.
3. Junior Lady Members may play in the Club Cup Trophy Competitions (other than those held exclusively for juniors) only if they hold a CONGU Handicap.
4. Between 4 and 24 medal competitions will normally be held on Wednesdays and weekends as published in the Fixture List. Stableford competitions will also be held on specific Wednesdays and weekends. All medal and stableford competitions are separate and open to all lady members with a CONGU handicap. Distance measuring devices are allowed in any Club Competition run under EWGA rules; however they are not allowed in County run competitions at the moment.
5. Club Trophy and Stroke Play Competitions shall be played over 18 and 27 holes. In the event of a tie the result shall be decided on count back.
6. Trophy Competitions – 3 Card Rule. To qualify for winning a Trophy Competition Ladies must have submitted 3 Qualifying cards (Medal and/or Qualifying stableford) in the previous 12 months. Ladies who have not submitted qualifying cards are still able to play in the Trophy Competitions but may not “win” the Trophy. Such cards may be deemed a Qualifying card.

RULES & REGULATIONS OF PLAY

MEN'S & MIXED COMPETITIONS

The most important rules (covering men's and mixed competitions) are as follows:

Competition entry: Other than medals, you must enter before the deadline by completing both the competition's book and submitting your entry fee. The deadline is always advertised but is generally 9-10 days before the event. This allows time for the draw to be posted before the weekend prior to the competition.

Reserve entry: After the deadline closes, a maximum of six (6) reserve entries may be made either in the book as above (i.e. fees paid in advance) or on the day. Reserves may be allocated tee times at the end of the draw or will be allocated spare slots in the main draw if others have withdrawn. Reserve players entering on the day of the competition will pay an additional £1 to the Captains' charity and must turn-up 15min before the first tee-time to be entered into the competition.

Withdrawing: If you need to withdraw from a drawn competition, you must do so by phoning the **Competitions Hotline 07864 068280** at least one hour before the first tee time or talking directly with the Competition's Secretary (not by leaving messages, emails etc).

Failing to turn up: Anyone who fails to turn up for their tee time or arrives after the next group's tee-time, will be disqualified from the event and receive a 2 competition ban.

Submission of cards: You (and only you) are responsible for submitting your card and it must be placed in the Competitions Box (NOT the smaller 'general play' box).

Lateness on the tee: Anyone who, without reasons due to exceptional circumstances, is not ready to play at their allotted tee time will incur a two shot penalty in a stroke play competition or loss of hole in a match play competition. Anyone who is more than 5 minutes late for a tee time, without reasons due to exceptional circumstances, will be disqualified from the competition.

Match Play competitions: Matches shall be played over 18 holes and if at the end of 18 holes the match is all square it shall continue until a hole is won, handicap strokes being taken as over the first 18 holes.

Both competitors in a match are responsible for arranging the match at a mutually convenient time within a period allowed for the round. No exceptions to play outside the round period are allowed without the prior permission of the Competitions Secretary. Winners must ensure their names are recorded on the Draw Sheet before the closing date for each round. In the event that the match is not played by the due date, the Competition Secretary shall determine the circumstances and have sole discretion as to the result which may include but not be limited to: (i) awarding the match to one party, (ii) deciding by the toss of a coin or (iii) disqualifying both of the competitors.

Stroke Index: In a mixed competition Ladies shall play off the Ladies Stroke Index.

Mixing match-play and stroke-play: Players are reminded that, under Rule 33-1 of the Rules of Golf, match-play rounds in official competitions cannot be combined simultaneously with any stroke-play events. In such cases, the player or players would be disqualified from the official competition event. If both events are official competitions, the disqualification would extend to both competitions.

Medals:

To enter medals and mid-week medals, you must sign the competitions book and submit your entry fee BEFORE you tee off. There are no exceptions. Unless agreed with the Competitions' Secretary in advance, a player's card must be marked only by a fellow competitor who is not an immediate family member or partner.

Between 8:15am and 9:30am, medal entrants should play in groups of three players (irrespective of how many of the group are entered in the medal).

Completion of cards: As part of a valid round, you are responsible for correctly completing a signed card including your handicap and the gross score on every hole. Addition of scores or calculation of stableford points etc is the responsibility of the Competitions Committee.
